Notes for GEORGES TANNOUS FREIJE:

"What I know about my grand father as was told by my mother. My great grand father Georges was the mayor of Maallaka a town near Zahle and used to be the hub. Now the role is reversed and Zahle became the hub. From

his seal at home, his full name is Geryius (Georges) Tannous(Tony) Freije. He was married to Saada Freije, her maiden name as well (this is according to Nageeb's residence). Georges and Saada had 8 children 4 girls and 4 boys. The boys Nageeb, Fuad, Farid, and Khalil. The Girls Zahiya, Bayke, Louisa, and Jenny. Zahiya and Bayke both lived and died in Lebanon. Louisa and Jenny immigrated to the U.S. The boys were educated at the Three Hierarchs Orthodox School in Souk El-Gharb(in Mount Lebanon), Lebanon. The school was a prestigious school. I mentioned to my mom that Saada maiden name is Freije on grandpa's residence. She said it's wrong because her mother told her that her family name is "Abou Trad." My mother also mentioned that back home, we have letters from her uncles and aunts to her father. She mentioned letters from Fuad, but I can't recall the letters. Georges died in Maallaka also before 1925. " SOURCE Naji Freije, Montreal and Lebanon. (note: according to the Sahda Freije's death certificate she was a widow at the time of her death.

Georges Freije arrived at Ellis Island on August 25th 1902. He was 50 years old, his daughter Louise traveled with him, she was 18 years old.

They stayed with Georges son Kahlil (Michael) at 79 Washington Street, New York City.

Notes for SAADA MEMER:

Sometimes refereed to as Sada or Sadie Freije, arrives in the United States in 1903 per 1910 census. According to the 1910 census Sada was 70 years old and had 14 children. Only 8 children were surviving at the time of the census. Resides at 53 Congress Street at the time of her death, source, Troy City Directoy.

Important Authors Note: In regards to the sons of Georges Freije of Zahleh, Lebanon

I am in possession of a Freije family tree that came to me through a gentleman named Fareed Abou-Haidar. I have not and will not published it on my website. This hand written family tree came from Lebanon and goes back many generations. Fareed painstakingly transcribed the tree and put it into an understandable format. For a person like myself, it is like striking gold. The tree only follows the male lineage. I was able to find my grandfather on this tree, the name of his father, brothers and forefathers. It also had the names of my uncles, excluding one. The original tree from what I understand is not an official government document. It is a word of mouth document, gathered, maintained and handed down through the years. This document has been a valuable source of information.

I have also gathered information from the grandchildren of Nageeb Freije. Nageeb Freije was my grandfathers older brother. He was born in Zahleh, Lebanon, came to the United States as a young man, he married and raised a family in Brooklyn, New York. After his wife passed away he returned to Lebanon as an American Citizen and remarried. Before Nageeb passed away in 1939 he managed to have another family. Some of his grandchildren now live in Canada and I have managed to be in contact with them through my website.

According to the Freije family tree, Georges Freije had 4 sons, Khalil, Nageeb, Fareed and Fouad (my grandfather). I have been able to find all sort of documents on all of the brothers from a variety of sources, such as, Ellis Island, Citizenship Applications, World War military registrations, City Directories, Newspapers and Census information. I believed that Khalil had Americanized his name to Michael in the same manner his brothers had all Americanized their names. However, Khalil Freije and Michael Freije are separate people. To add to this confusion both Khalil and Michael married women named Ameenie. Go figure. So, as it turns out, after years of research, Khalil Freije married Ameenie Sahadi and Michael Freije married Ameenie Khoury. This very well might have confused the original family tree maker, the cousin of Fareed Abou-Haidar. This means that Michael Freije is not on our family tree. But, my Aunts and Uncles all well remember his wife and always referred to her as Aunt Ameenie from Long Island. My grandmother and Aunts and Uncles attended her funeral and wake. Michael Freije's family lived in Cohoes and Troy, New York. The Troy house they lived in was a house my grandfather had also lived in. They also lived in Brooklyn and were married in Brooklyn in 1908. Michael Freije was in the Fruit business same as my grandfather. Michael Freije was also in business with Nageeb Freije in 1924. There is no reason as of now to discount him as being a brother of my grandfather. There

is also no reason to discount Khalil Freije as a brother of my grandfather. Khalil died before 1915 and it is pretty much without question that Khalil and Nageeb Freije were brothers and both sons of Georges Freije. As always, research continues.

For now, I am adding a brother to my grandfather on the family tree. It will stay this way until new information arises.

In my most recent research I have found Louise Freije married to Michael Aboussleman. I found this on the Kerge Family Tree on Ancestry.com. I was able to contact the person who submitted this name, the person could not provide any backup evidence in this matter what-so-ever. Louise Freije arrived in Ellis Island with her father in 1902. It was the most common practice to have marriages prearranged and Louise may have been handed over to her awaiting Brides-groom. Michael Abouseleman resided in Brooklyn, NY and everything seems to fit. The matter remains unconfirmed speculation.

Please let me share with you the family background I know of.

Little is known about my great grandfather Michael. The story according to family bits and pieces goes that the family moved from Troy to Brooklyn. Michael abandoned his family leaving town with his sister-in law (Amenia's brother's wife.) After this the family moved to their summer residence in Bayshore Long Island. This is where they remained. I spoke with my great uncle Al. He said he remembers his mother visiting Troy often to see friends. He also said he has great regret that he never really got to take any history or account of his family. it is my belief that at the time the family was ashamed and Michael was never spoken of. My grandmother never met her husbands(Fred) father. She said before they were married that Michael died and that my grandfather had to go down south to claim the body. It is my grandmothers account that Amenia sold "high end" items door to door and that is how the family survived. My grandmother and great Uncle are still alive. #### COHOES MARKET OWNER FRED FREIJE IN BUSINESS 50 YEARS -

Fred Freije Sr., 71 market owner in the Cohoes-Troy area for nearly half a century, died at 5:30 p.m. yesterday at St. Mary's Hospital where he was confined after being stricken more than four months ago. One of the first to come to this area from his native Middle East Lebanon, Mr. Freije died shortly after realizing one of his lifetime ambitions. On May 4 one day after he suffered a cerebral hemorrhage, his five sons opened the Big Value Market in Waterford which was built and equipped at an estimated cost of \$300,000. His Cohoes residence was at 240 Saratoga St.

Began In 1906. Mr. Freije first entered the area food store business in 1906 when he opened a food and vegetable establishment in Troy of 4th St. North of Congress. Without formal education, he continued to expand in the field and later establish a larger store at the present site of the White Tower Restaurant at Congress and 3rd Streets. In Cohoes, where he was perhaps most widely known, Mr. Freije opened his first store on Remsen Street and later founded the Big Value Market at Main and Columbia Streets. The latter establishment was wrecked by fire Saturday, August 27, and has been closed since. Mr. Freije also was a founder of St. Ann's Church in Troy in 1913, and was one of its communicants, and for many years a member of the board of trustees. Helped Countrymen. His countrymen who came here after him found him through the years a willing counsel and advisor. He was noted for his wide support of church activities and he was a member of the Holy Name Society. Beside his widow the former Mary Ferris, he is survived by five sons, George, Philip, Charles, Fred Jr. and Joseph Freije, all of Cohoes and three daughters, Misses Margaret and Mary Freije, both of Cohoes, and Mrs. William Luke of Latham.
